



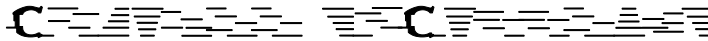

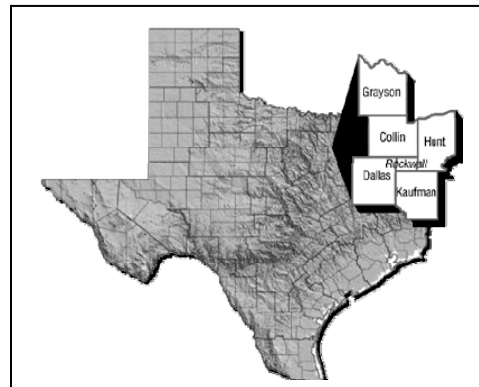

Speaker: Justice Carolyn Wright
Chief Justice of the Fifth Court of Appeals

Justice Wright is currently one of thirteen justices on the Fifth District Court of Appeals. She sits on a rotating panel of three justices who decide criminal, civil, family, juvenile, and probate matters that are appealed from trial courts in seven North Texas counties from which she is elected. Justice Carolyn Wright has served in the judiciary for more than 20 years.



The Court of Appeals for the Fifth District of Texas at Dallas has jurisdiction over appeals from both district and county courts

located in Dallas, Collin, Grayson, Hunt, Rockwall and Kaufman counties. The Court hears both civil and criminal appeals.

Eric Golub is Brooklyn born, Long Island raised, and has lived in Los Angeles since 1990. He received his Bachelors degree from the University of Judaism, and his MBA from USC.

He has been a stockbrokerage professional since 1994. He began blogging on March 11th, 2007, the three year anniversary of the Madrid bombings and the midpoint of 9/11.

Mr. Golub's blog is the "Tygrrrr Express," and in April of 2009 he published the book "Ideological Bigotry." It is endorsed on the back cover by Ward Connerly and Armstrong Williams.

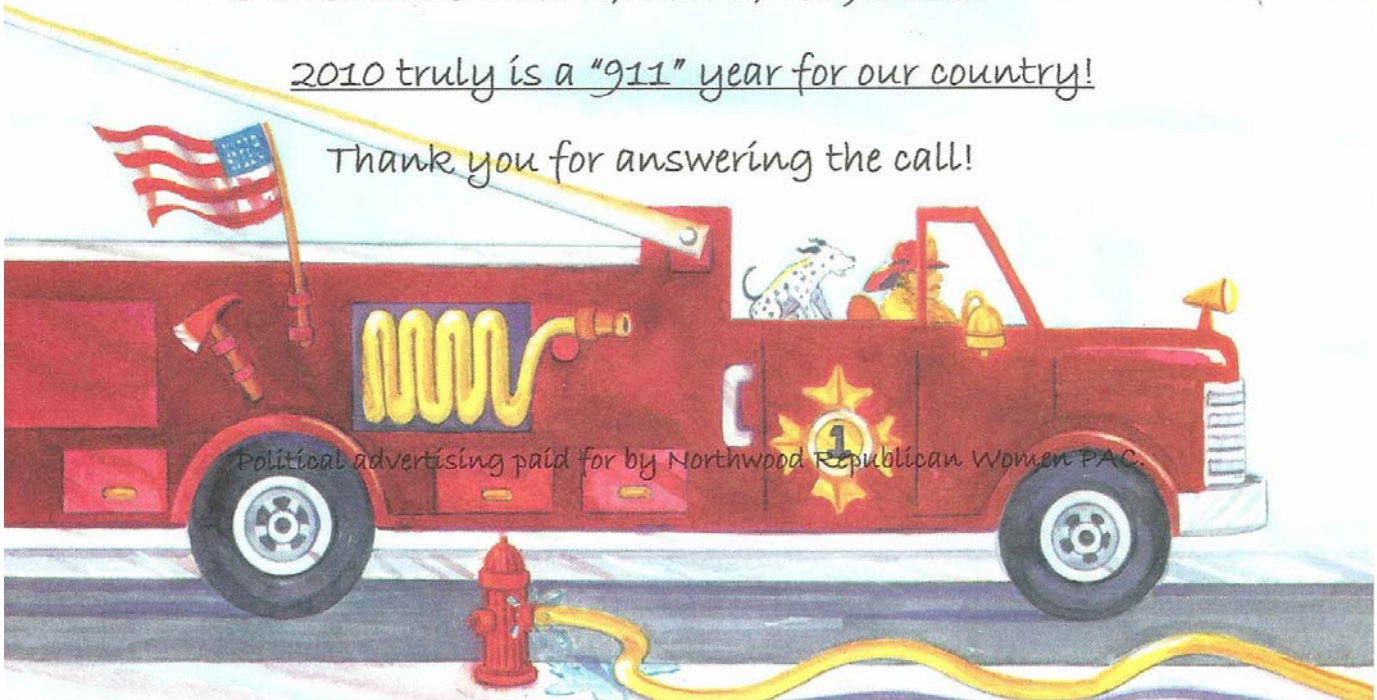
